All services are cancelled, with the exception of a live stream of our Sunday 11am worship which will be available through Facebook Live. We also wanted to make available to you the opportunity to join the congregation for the live stream, so we will have about six(6) specially designated seating areas of eight(8) seats distanced throughout the Sanctuary. There will be no childcare provided.

The church and sanctuary also will be accessible Monday-Thursday from 9:00am-Noon for anyone who wishes to come by for prayer and personal worship at the altar.

We understand these are unprecedented times and this critical decision has not come without counsel and much prayer. We also want you to be aware that we continue to monitor this fluid situation and community guidelines and will communicate with you any changes.

We highly encourage anyone in the high-risk or symptomatic categories to allow your church family to minister to you in many ways over this time and one way is to remain home and utilize the live broadcast option. We at PFBC are blessed with many faithful ones whose most appreciated ministry in the body is the ministry of your PRESENCE. Just being present encourages so many, however, we would encourage you to be wise in these days for your well being and that of others.
